Introduction & Purpose

Welcome to the WTSQ Community Podcast Studio! Our goal is to provide a space for local creators to produce high-quality podcasts/audio while fostering community engagement. Content recorded in this studio may be featured on WTSQ.org and CharlesTunes, our alternative stream dedicated to local and regional artists and creators.

Booking & Access

- The studio is open to the public and available by reservation only. Click [here to access](#) the calendar.
 - **All first-time users must attend** at least one training session with a WTSQ representative before accessing the studio independently.
 - Scheduling is managed through Podcast@WTSQ.org, which hosts a [public calendar](#) for booking.
 - After your initial training session in the studio, your experience will be self-directed. User guides and instruction manuals for your convenience. We recommend browsing these resources to get started:

 - Upon confirmation of your booking, you will receive a single-use door access code.
 - When checking out, be sure to scan the check-out QR Code which logs your session, clean and organize the space, and ensure lights are off and doors are locked.
 - Please respect your reserved time and leave the studio promptly when finished.

Equipment Usage

- The studio is equipped with professional-grade microphones and mixers.
 - **Users must bring their own SD card for recording.** The Tascam Mixcast 4 also allows a laptop connection via USB, and you may record directly to [Tascam's free podcast](#) editing software using your laptop.
 - Additionally, a computer equipped with Audacity is available in the studio space for mixing your podcast.
 - Users are responsible for handling equipment with care and reporting any issues immediately to Podcast@WTSQ.org.
 - Any damage caused due to negligence may result in financial responsibility or loss of access.

Studio Etiquette & Cleanup

- Again please arrive on time for your session and be mindful of others who have booked the space.
 - No food or drinks are permitted near the equipment—only water bottles with closed lids.
 - Clean up after yourself and return all equipment to its designated place.
 - If you make changes to any settings, please restore them to their original configuration before leaving.

 - WTSQ reserves the right to refuse to publish or promote content that does not align with our community standards.

Publishing & Distribution

- WTSQ may publish select podcast episodes on WTSQ.org if the content aligns with our existing media programming.
 - WTSQ may publish select podcast episodes on CharlesTunes, our 24/7 alternative stream, which will feature content from local and regional creators.
 - Creators are free to distribute their content independently as well.
