



INSIDE THE CREATIVE PULSE: AN IN-DEPTH CONVERSATION WITH LOCAL MUSICIANS

🎵 Local Spotlight: Joe Cevallos 🎵

This month, we caught up with Charleston's own Joe Cevallos, a talented multi-instrumentalist whose sound can be heard across a range of local bands and genres. Here's what he had to say:

Q: Can you tell us a bit about your musical journey—how you got started and what inspired you to become a musician?

Joe: "I've been playing music since I was a kid. I got my start in the West Virginia Youth Symphony, played in a bunch of local theater pits, the GWHS band, and even a little jazz group with some familiar Charleston faces. Music's always been part of my world."

Q: What bands or projects are you currently involved in, and how would you describe the style or sound of each?

Joe: "Right now I'm playing with The Company Stores, Cariño, and Hot Jazz of Charleston. Each one has a different vibe—The Company Stores blend folk, rock, and soul; Cariño brings a fun Latin-inspired dance energy; and Hot Jazz of Charleston taps into that classic, vintage jazz sound. I also do a Celtic solo set from time to time."

Q: What instrument(s) do you play, and do you have a favorite or one you feel most connected to?

Joe: "My main instruments are trumpet and violin, but I also break out the harmonica or penny whistle when the moment calls for it. Honestly, I love them all—it depends on the gig."

Q: Any upcoming shows or events we should have on our radar?

Joe: "For sure! Come dance with us—Cariño is playing The Roq on June 28th. And definitely grab tickets for the WV Symphony's 'Listen Where You Live' concert on October 25th, where The Company Stores and other local acts will be playing alongside the Symphony. It's going to be a big night for Charleston music."
